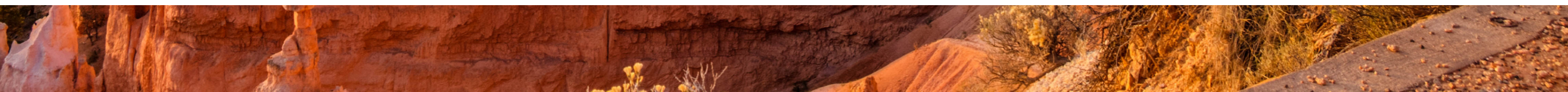




LANDSCAPES

HOMework ASSIGNMENT

.....

- Shoot at least 36 images with a landscapes
- Be sure to consider the lighting for your location based on the time of day you will be photographing it
- Submit your 8 strongest images as an 8-up contact sheet
- Submit your #1 image for critique during class as both a print and the digital file



TIPS FOR LANDSCAPE PHOTOGRAPHY

.....

- Get outside and shoot!
- Pick the best time of day for your location
- Look for a focal point and use your composition to frame it
- Consider using points of interest in the foreground and background
- Think of what is more interesting - the sky or foreground - and frame accordingly



TIPS FOR LANDSCAPES

- Add a sense of scale by including something of a known size, such as a person, tree, car or animal
- For night photography, be sure to bring a tripod
- Give yourself time to explore
- Frame each scene several ways, and try different directions, in other words, walk around
- Find leading lines in your shot
